The aetiology of this pathologic condition remains unclear. Tendinopathies have been linked to overuse, poor vascularity, lack of flexibility, genetic make-up, gender, endocrine or metabolic factors. Excessive loading of the tendon during vigorous physical training is regarded as the main pathological stimulus.

Chronic, long-lasting Achilles tendon disorders can range from overuse injuries to tearing of the tendon. Pain in the heel is often caused by a combination of both acute and chronic problems. These include inflammatory conditions – such as paratenonitis, chronic Achilles tendonitis, insertional tendonitis and retrocalcaneal bursitis – and the degenerative condition known as tendinosis .

The Achilles tendon or heel cord, also known as the calcaneal tendon, is a tendon at the back of the lower leg, and is the thickest in the human body. It serves to attach the plantaris, gastrocnemius and soleus muscles to the calcaneus bone. These muscles, acting via the tendon, cause plantar flexion of the foot at the ankle joint, and flexion at the knee. Abnormalities of the Achilles tendon include inflammation, degeneration, rupture, and becoming embedded with cholesterol deposits.
